## **COVID-19 Safety Information:**

- All students and staff on campus must wear masks when indoors. Common Ground will provide
  masks for each student but strongly encourage that students arrive in masks, especially if
  traveling using public transportation.
- 1 way masks (with an air vent) are not permitted. If your child has a medical condition that

  addressed and may include removal from the learning environment.
- **IMPORTANT:** Please take the time to answer the invitation email from "SchoolDocs", which is our electronic medical records (EMR) program that helps us keep track of health office visits, Doctor Physicals, immunization status, as well as any updates to students' health needs. **School Docs will be the place where you upload proof of Covid Vaccination status.**

## **Instructional Needs:**

• **Chromebooks**: All students entering Common Ground will be loaned a Google Chromebook that will be necessary to participate in all classes. There is a \$35/year insurance fee that must be paid by prior to August 31st, to enable distribution of Chromebooks and training at Freshman Orientation. During orientation, 9<sup>th</sup> graders will be learning about their devices and specific programs they will be using during the school year so it is essential that all 9<sup>th</sup> graders pay these insurance fees prior to August 31st, the first day of 9th grade orientation.

Our Chromebook Student Use Agreement, enclosed in this mailing, provides important details about this program. If your student has not been issued a Chromebook and/or has not paid the insurance fee, we are accepting insurance fees now. Please call the school's main office to schedule the chromebook pickup and/or call Ana Rosa at 203-389-0823 ext. 1202 to pay by credit card for the insurance fee.

- School Calendar: The school calendar for 2021-2022 is enclosed. Please note: we do not follow the New Haven Public School calendar exactly so it is very important that you review the Common Ground calendar carefully.
- School Supplies: A back-to-school supplies list is enclosed. Please check the supplies list
  carefully so your student has what they need to be successful this year. <u>ALL students need a
  graphing calculator for math.</u>
- Student Registration: All students must be registered to begin the 2021-2022 year at Common Ground. If your student is not registered at Common Ground please call the school at 389-0823 ext. 1200 or 1202 to schedule your registration appointment.
